



NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC FROM YOUR TAOS COUNTY ASSESSOR MARIA DIMAS

The Taos County Assessor's Office will be mailing out the 2022 Notices of Valuation to all property owners on Friday, April 1st, 2022. Please review this document carefully as this value will be a factor in determining your 2022 property tax bill. If you disagree with the value or classification of your property you have until Monday, May 2nd, 2022 to file a protest with our office and to apply for the following exemptions:

- Head of Family Exemption (primary residence)
- Veteran and Disabled Veteran Exemptions
- 65 & Older or 100% Disabled Valuation Freeze (modified gross income of \$37,300 or less)
- Claim of Exemption for Non-Governmental Entities

Confirming your most current address will guarantee that you receive all future Notice of Valuations and Property Tax Bills.
