



**TAOS COUNTY
RESOLUTION NO. 2025-38
CREATING A LIVING COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Taos County Board of Commissioners is the duly authorized governing body of Taos County, a New Mexico political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the requirements of the grant used to fund the comprehensive planning process, the Taos County Board of Commissioners adopted the Taos County Comprehensive Plan on April 15, 2025 with an effective date of July 18, 2025; and

WHEREAS, while multiple requests to extend the time to complete the plan were approved by the New Mexico Finance Authority and the County invested additional funding to expand the initial plan, the interest of our community members and partners to actively engage in the process and further develop the Taos County Comprehensive Plan grew exponentially; and

WHEREAS, the input of our citizens has clarified that to get the most value out of a Comprehensive Plan, government should treat it not just as a static document, but as a strategic, actionable, and community-driven tool; and


WHEREAS, to fully benefit from the knowledge, experience and passion for civic engagement of our community members, the Taos County Board of Commissions has determined to make the County Comprehensive Plan a "living document" that evolves with changing conditions, community needs, and policy priorities on a timely basis.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Taos County Board of Commissioners, that staff be directed to develop a formal amendment and update process for the Taos County Comprehensive Plan that includes community engagement mechanisms, periodic reporting, and aligns with other County policies and ordinances.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution No. 2025-38 supersedes Resolution No. 2025-10 to allow for ongoing input and updates to the 2025 Taos County Comprehensive Plan draft.
